Arts and Music in Schools (AMS) Funding Guarantee and Accountability Act 2024-25 Annual Report

On November 8, 2022, California voters approved Proposition 28: The Arts and Music in Schools (AMS) Funding Guarantee and Accountability Act, requiring the state to establish a new, ongoing program supporting arts instruction in schools beginning in 2023-24.

This is the second annual report to the Board regarding how the funding has been used, including expenditures in the following areas:

- The number of full-time equivalent teachers, classified personnel, and teaching aides
- The number of pupils served
- The number of school sites providing arts education programs with AMS funds

For the 2024-25 school year, AMS expenditures have included supplies, materials and arts educations programs. In 2024-25 EPMS added music classes for grades 1-6, adding a certificated 0.34 FTE position. EPMS continued with the additional 0.15 classified FTE for the Art classes offered in the 7-8 grade classes that were added in the 23-24 school year with AMS funds. Grades 1-3 are also receiving art education in the form of Art classes, which are ongoing and not supported by AMS funds.
