Arts and Music in Schools (AMS) Funding Guarantee and Accountability Act

2025-26 Annual Report

On November 8, 2022, California voters approved Proposition 28: The Arts and Music in Schools (AMS) Funding Guarantee and Accountability Act, requiring the state to establish a new, ongoing program supporting arts instruction in schools beginning in 2023-24.

This is the third annual report to the Board regarding how the funding has been used, including expenditures in the following areas:

- The number of full-time equivalent teachers, classified personnel, and teaching aides
- The number of pupils served
- The number of school sites providing arts education programs with AMS funds

For the 2025-26 school year, AMS expenditures have included supplies, materials, and salaries & benefits for additional arts education programs. In 2025-26 school year, EPMS continued using AMS funds for an additional 0.40 FTE position for Music classes offered in grades 1-6 (added in 2024-25) and an additional 0.15 FTE position for Art classes offered in grades 7-8 (added in 23-24). Grades 1-6 are also receiving art education in the form of Art classes, which are ongoing and not supported by AMS funds.
